From the Pastor...

October 2022 Newsletter


Autumn has arrived. The seasons have definitely changed: the temperatures have dropped, the leaves are turning, and football is back on Sunday (and I promise that the sermon will be done in time to get you home for noon kickoffs). There have also been a number of changes here at Living Hope.

The first major change is in our masking policy. In consultation with Dickson Hollow, masks are no longer required for attending worship or other functions in person. If you prefer to wear a mask, we welcome that choice to keep yourself and others safer. The Session has decided that we will continue to have seats socially

distanced and we will not restart fellowship time yet. Session will continue to revisit these policies on a monthly basis to determine if it is safe to further relax our standards or if we need to return to masking due to a rise in infections. We do, however, ask that if you are not feeling well or have symptoms that



may indicate COVID, you participate remotely to minimize the chance of spreading COVID or other illnesses.



We also have a new video system in place in the chapel and fellowship hall. Purchased in conjunction with Dickson Hollow, this new system is a high-definition digital camera that can be refocused during the service to zoom in on particular parts of the sanctuary. Additionally, we opted to add a component that allows for live streaming of the services. Over the next month

we will be transitioning over to having our services streamed on YouTube with access directly from Living Hope's webpage [www.livinghopepcusa.org/livestream]. This will also allow us to record and save the services for future viewing. This means that you can watch the service at a later time if a Sunday morning is difficult, or you can go back and watch a particular part of the service that you found meaningful at any time. With this change, we will still continue to have our worship services available via Zoom for the foreseeable future.

Even with all the changes that are occurring, several things remain the same.

- First, God's love and faithfulness will be the same, today, tomorrow, and forever.
- Second, the people of Living Hope Presbyterian continue to be committed to one another and the mission of Jesus Christ that flows through this congregation.

Over the coming month, look for information about our 2023 Stewardship Campaign, **Committed Together**, as we discern how we are called to continue to support one another and this congregation's mission to the local community and the world.


Peace & Global Witness offering

These gifts also unite us with Presbyterian peacemakers across the country and the world who are active, not passive; who are doing, not waiting.


25% of this Offering will stay with your congregation to for our own ministries of peacemaking and reconciliation.


