When we think about how we live our faith, we often think about our prayer life and attending worship. But there are many other aspects of life that are expressions of us living out our faith. The way we continue to learn about God and how we can think about God and God's actions is one that we do through study. How we care for our church family and friends acts as an expression of the love that we have received from God. The ways we reach out to those who are in need also help us live our faith.

During the entire month of May and into early June we, as a congregation, will work on living out our faith through service to the broader world.

Partnering with Mr. Bob's Under the Bridge, the entire month of May we will be holding a clothing drive for people living without a home. People are asked to bring gently used or new clothing to the church to be passed



on to Mr. Bob's. A list of preferred items is located on page 3 of this newsletter. We would ask that all items be at the church by June 1st for us to take to Mr. Bob's on June 2nd.



On May 18th we will plant our vegetable planters that we tend and send the produce to Apostle Presbyterian Church in West Allis for distribution at their food pantry. This is done in coordination with Food for the Journey, a coalition of six Presbyterian congregations in suburban Milwaukee. We are looking for folks to come and help plant the vegetables on the third Sunday of May and then also for folks to volunteer to check on the planters one day a week and water them if needed. There is no need to sign up for planting on the 18th. Watering sign-up sheets are available starting Sunday May 4th. Check with the ushers about where to sign up.

On June 8th we will celebrate the day of Pentecost with the Sterling and Brass Quintet, geraniums to take home (a gift from the Deacons), and also have our next sandwich making session. After worship we will gather to make sandwiches and lunch bags for The Guest House. In October, we were able to make a few hundred sandwiches in just a short period of time. This time we are looking to do that same. Many hands will make light work and you will be


