

From the Pastor...

October 2025 Newsletter

A few months ago, we announced a new tagline for our congregation. It is a quick summary of our mission and vision statement and also helps to guide the ministry we do as a congregation. You may have noticed it on our bulletin or remember me speaking about it briefly at the start of worship on one Sunday this summer. Our new tag line is: Living Hope | Living Faith.

Session decided on using this tagline in June as a way to give us language to talk about our congregation in a way that is straight forward, but also has some "play" in it. In this tagline, you can understand it in multiple ways. It says in a simple way that Living Hope Presbyterian Church is living faith. But it can also mean a number of different things depending on the way you interpret the *living*'s, as adjectives or verbs. We can understand that our hope and faith are alive and active, guiding our lives and actions together. We can think about it as we are actively living out hope and faith in all that we do with worship, service, mission, and care for each other and the world. We can also talk about it as hope and faith that are alive and growing as opposed to dead and static.

Living Hope is all of these. We are a congregation that actively gathers to live our faith and hope through worship. We come together to serve others with our resources and our activities, doing mission projects that



involve us sharing hope and faith with those in hard situations. We live with one another in care and compassion, speaking of hope and faith even when it seems like life is really hard and trying to take away any ray of hope. We gather for times of learning and seeking, asking questions together about faith and life, allowing the Spirit to grow within us, giving us faith and hope that respond to new situations and new possibilities, changing us slowly over time into people who more closely reflect Christ.

As we come to stewardship season at the end of this month, we have the chance to once again ask ourselves if the way we are living shows hope and faith. How do our individual lives and life together reflect hope and faith into the world around us? How do we use our time and resources both individually and communally to strength hope and faith in ourselves and others? How do we steward the gift of faith we have been given by God in a way that it grows and lives within us so God can use us even more fully? How do we live hope and live faith in this world that seems to foster despair and cynicism? In short, how are we Living Hope | Living Faith?

community of faith and encourage their continued work of bringing beauty into the world.






